



REPORT on

GLOBAL INNOVATION FORUM IN OSAKA

The Global Innovation Forum (GIF) 2019, which was organized by the Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (OCCI) and the Osaka Business and Investment Center (O-BIC) was held at Grandfront Osaka, during October10-11, 2019.

A total of 17 startups from 8 countries (USA, UK, Israel, Germany, China, Singapore, France, Japan), especially in the advanced sectors such as AI/IoT, VR, Digital Health, etc. were invited to this forum. On the first day, the opening ceremony was held and Consul Generals from 9 countries have attended. Demonstration was held by the startups, with more than 300 participants from Japanese companies, VCs, universities, etc. Many of the participants visited the startups' booths, and actively exchanged information, which showed their strong interest in collaborating with overseas startups with advanced technology.

On the second day, at the Forum Mr. John Byrnes, Founder / Co-CEO of Ai Collaborator has come from Silicon Valley to give the keynote address receiving more than 140 attendees. The keynote address was followed by business presentations given by the startups.

B2B meetings were also held simultaneously, and a total of 97 business talks were held. Both the startups and Japanese companies gave positive comments at the end, that it was beneficial for the business development of both sides.
